I can't eat this.

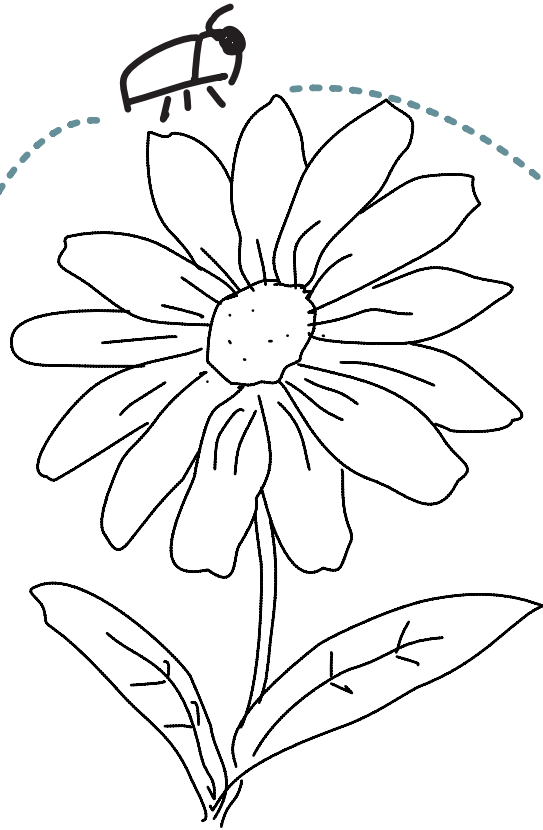
Dear reader, bon appétit!



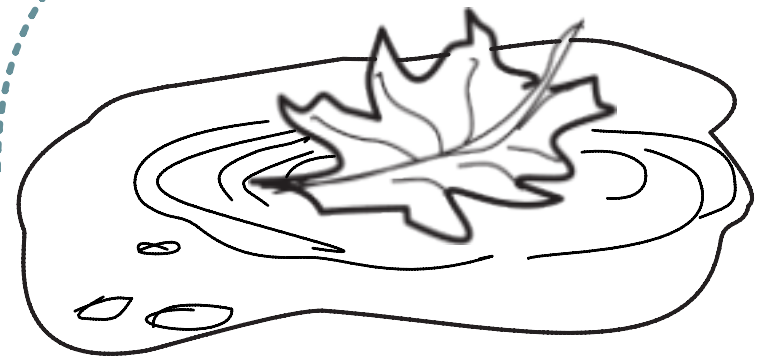
Let's go see what's over here.

Hm. I don't see anything to eat here.

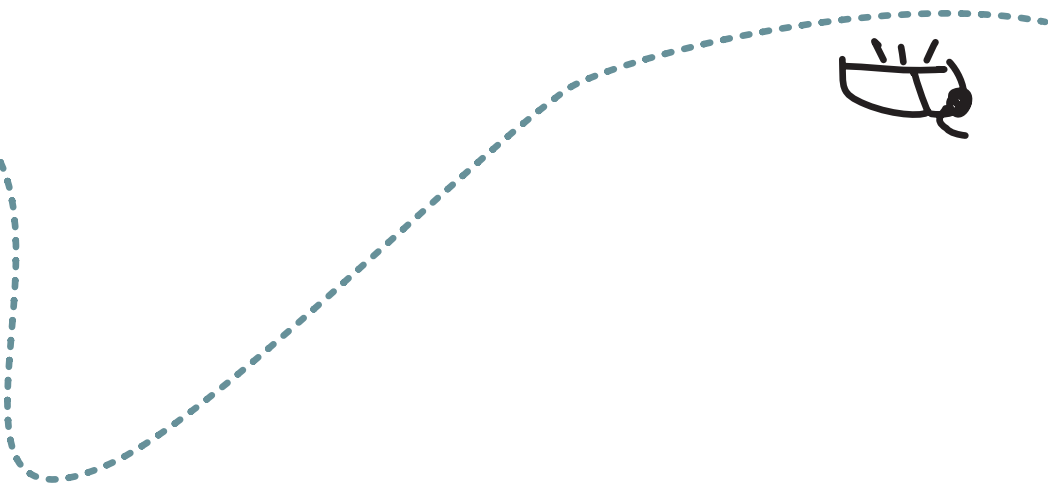


Maybe if I climb up here

Oh no! Help! I'm falling over!

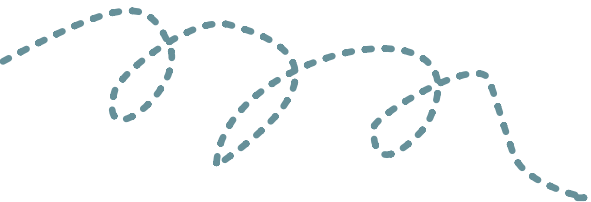
Careful - remember what
happened last time!



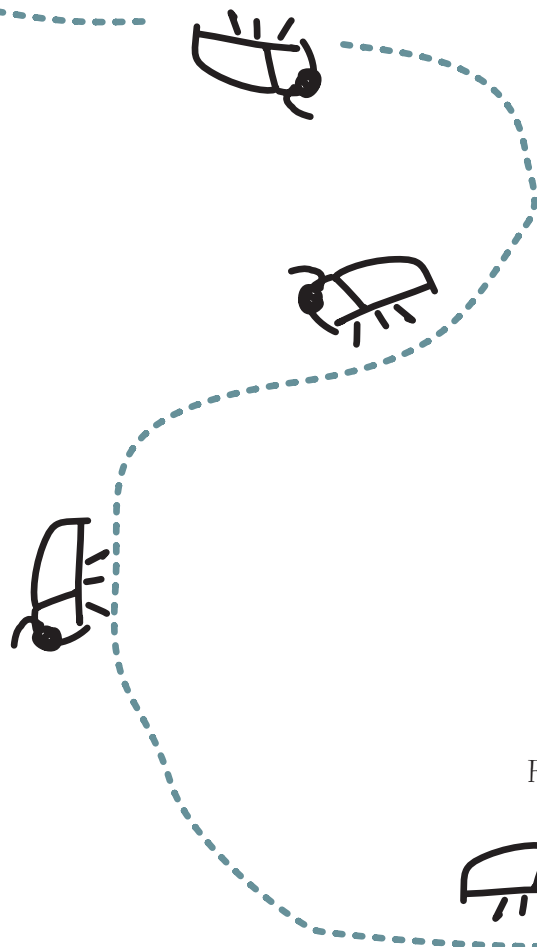
Thanks. Let's keep going.

going in the right direction?



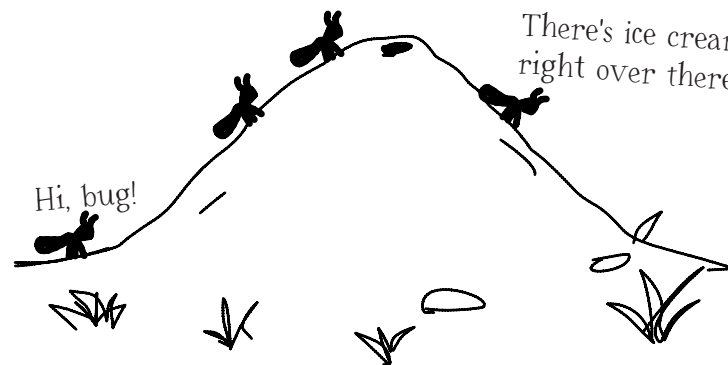
Fantastic! Let's go!

Hi, bug!

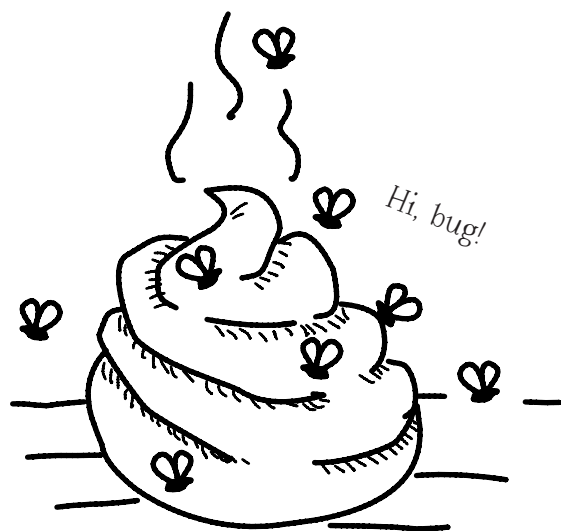


There's ice cream
right over there.

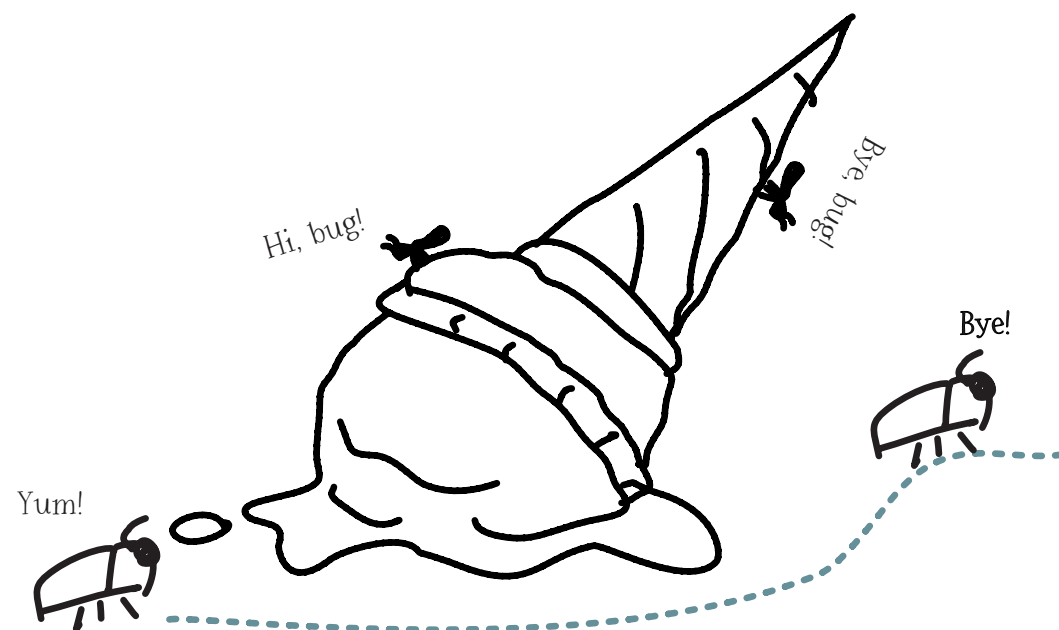
Thanks!
